Guide for Authors

1. The journal aims primarily to support the publication opportunities of PhD students and doctoral candidates.
2. We publish independent scientific works based on own research activity, related to the doctoral research topic, which have not been published elsewhere.
3. Articles can be written in Hungarian, in English or in German languages. For each study, an abstract in English language shall be written (minimum 400 maximum 600 characters) and 4-6 keywords must also be marked in English.
4. The length of the dissertations can be a minimum of 40,000 and a maximum of 60,000 characters (with spaces).
5. Please indicate your affiliation with footnote to the author's name (affiliation shall consist: name, grade, university, institute, department, if any: ORCID number, supervisor's name and position)
6. The following rules shall be applied to editing the text of the article:
 - The body text is Garamond 10 font size.
 - Make the text single-spaced.
 - Margin size: Top: 1.5 cm Bottom: 1.5 cm, Outer: 1.5 cm, Inside: 2 cm
 - Page Setup - Paper Size: 14.8 cm x 21 cm
 - Tab 0.5 cm
 - Please do not use any page numbering and headings!
 - Please use footnotes, not endnotes. The footnote is Garamond 8 font size.
 - For internet links, please indicate the date of download in brackets after the link according to the following format: (date of download: 20/04/2020)
 - Only italics can be used as highlights in the text. (Neither underline, bold, or bold italics can be used!)
 - A separate bibliography must be provided at the end of the study.
